

Queensland Youth Band Development Camp 2023

Monday 9th January – Friday 13th January 2023

QCCC Brookfield, 179 Gold Creek Road, Brookfield, Queensland (Brisbane)

We invite all young Queensland players to attend the 2023 Youth Band Camp, proudly hosted by the Queensland Band Association. The Youth Band Camp is open to all young brass and percussion players. (10 years – 19 years inclusive).

[QCCC Brookfield](#) has been selected as the site for the 2023 camp. Brookfield is a 35-minute drive from the city centre. The site provides modern, clean, ensuited accommodation, quality meals and excellent facilities. **Players** will be involved in band rehearsals, sectionals and tutorial sessions. Time will also be allocated to enjoy the pool, tennis courts, beach volleyball and games room.

Band members must be **19 years or under** to participate. Experience has shown us that players with skills of at least **AMEB Grade 3** gain the most from this group, however others may be considered on the basis of their playing history. A Camp Coordinator and House Parents are appointed by the QBA. QBA representatives are first aid qualified and all adults on site have current blue cards.

Registration (check in) will be **on Monday 9th January** at QCCC Brookfield. Players will have a short briefing and engage in their first rehearsals. The camp will **conclude with a free concert** for family, friends, and the general public, on **Friday 13th January 2023 at 2:00pm**.

- Return your **application form and \$50 deposit on or before 31 October 2022** (pages 2-5) to the QBA Secretary. **NB – Scholarship applications (page 6) are due 30 November 2022**
- PLEASE NOTE: spots fill up fast and will be taken on a first-in basis, so get your applications in quick!
- Eligible applications **from regional areas** will receive a travel subsidy from our sponsors, Yamaha Australia and Brass Music Specialists. We will notify you regarding the subsidy after applications have been finalized.

Our Musical Director for 2023



David Bremner is Principal trombone of the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra, a position he has held since 2002. Prior to this appointment, he was principal trombone of the Auckland Philharmonic. Born in New Plymouth, David began his early musical studies on cornet and euphonium under the tutelage of his father Trevor Bremner. After moving to Trombone, he went on to graduate with Honours from Victoria University of Wellington studying with Marc Taddei; was awarded the prestigious Patricia Pratt Scholarship to study at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music, and graduated with a Master of Music degree studying with Mark Lawrence. As a soloist, David has performed concertos with the NZ Symphony Orchestra and in 2009, released his debut solo CD *Gung-Ho*, featuring the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra and the National Brass Band of NZ. David has also recorded with the New Zealand rock band 'Crowded House', performed with the San Francisco Symphony Orchestra and the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra of London, as well as many brass bands across Australasia and the UK. He is heavily involved in music education in NZ, previously teaching trombone at the NZ School of Music for over 10 years and is currently a trustee of the Kia Ora Foundation; the presenter of Brilliant Brass on Radio Concert & the Musical Director of the New Zealand Youth Band and the National Band of New Zealand. David was a popular member of the faculty for the 2017 Lower Brass Weekend, hosted by Griffith University Qld Conservatorium of Music and A Grade adjudicator for the Australian National Band Championships 2018. **Following the recent Covid pandemic, David is very keen to be able to return to Australia in 2023 to conduct the 2023 QLD Youth Band Development Camp!**

GUIDELINES FOR PLAYERS & THEIR FAMILIES

1. **Smoking and Alcohol consumption** are not permitted at this camp at any time.
2. Camp participants are to accept all instructions from the camp staff and/ or QBA Houseparents. The staff and/ or QBA Houseparents reserve the right to send home at parents' or player's expense any participant who wilfully and consistently refuses to comply with instructions. If for any reason whatsoever, a player returns home, all costs incurred (including that of a chaperone) are to be borne by the parents/guardians of the player.
3. Participants will not be allowed to leave the camp unless in the care of a staff member or by prior written agreement between the member and his/her parents.
4. Band members are expected to **respect** the **property** of the QBA and that of our host venue.
5. A current medical form must be submitted prior to any player joining the camp.
6. Whilst on camp, parents may not remove their child from the camp without the Camp Coordinator's permission.
7. By signing this form, I give permission for the QBA to use any photo taken of myself/my child for the purposes of news items or publicity including the publishing of names. If you wish to have your child exempt from this, please inform the Camp Coordinator prior to attending the camp.
